<p>Small Insect Eaters eg Superb Fairy- Wren, Spotted Pardalote, Brown Thornbill, White-Browed Scrubwren, Flame Robin, Grey Fantail, Willie Wagtail, Welcome Swallow, Weebill, Striated Thornbill</p>	<p>Local Acacia ulicifolia, Leptospermum myrsinoides Acacia sophorae, Leptospermum laevigatum Bursaria spinose.</p>	<p>Dense shrubs for protection and nest sites. Open areas are important for foraging. Check the Bayside Nursery list. Consider some prickly plants.</p>	<p>Carnivore birds, Wattle birds, Noisy Miners domestic cats and dogs (night curfew essential), pesticides</p>
<p>Seed eaters, Eastern Rosella, Crimson Rosella, Crested Pigeon, Common Bronze-winged Pigeon, Galah, Sulphur Crested Cockatoo,</p>	<p>Local Acacia ulicifolia, Leptospermum myrsinoides, Acacia sophorae Acacia paradoxa, Acacia mearnsli, Leptospermum laevigatum, Allocasuarina verticillata, choose local grasses from the range.</p>	<p>Shrubs and trees for perching, nesting and foraging. They forage on mature grasses. Hollows in trees and nesting boxes. Check the Bayside Nursery list. Consider prickly plants.</p>	<p>Carnivore birds, Wattle birds, Noisy Miners domestic cats and dogs (night curfew essential), pesticides</p>
<p>Fruit eaters eg Mistletoe Bird, Silvereye</p>	<p>Other Figs, Lillipillies, Native Mistletoe, especially Amayema and Muellerina.</p>	<p>Shrubs and trees are important habitat. Check the Bayside Nursery list.</p>	<p>Carnivore birds, Wattle birds, Noisy Miners domestic cats and dogs (night curfew essential), pesticides</p>
<p>Large Nectar eaters eg Rainbow Lorikeet, Little Lorikeet, Musk Lorikeet, Red Wattlebird, Little Wattlebird, Noisy Miner,</p>	<p>Local Banksia integrifolia, Melaleuca ericifolia,</p>	<p>Shrubs and trees for foraging, perching and nesting. Hollows in trees and nesting boxes for Parrots and Lorikeets. Check</p>	<p>Carnivore birds, domestic cats and dogs (night curfew essential), pesticides</p>

Larger Carnivores-Meat Eaters , Magpie Lark, Grey Butcherbird, Australian Magpie, Little Raven, Tawny Frogmouth, Pied Currawong, Laughing Kookaburra	Local Eucalyptus viminalis, Eucalyptus pauciflora	Tall trees for perching, roosting and nesting. Remember if you plant to encourage these birds they will have a negative impact on smaller birds.	Other carnivore birds , (eggs and fledglings), Wattle birds, Noisy Miners domestic cats and dogs (night curfew essential), pesticides
